

In-Person and Online Worship at University Presbyterian Church

We are resuming in-person worship in a limited way starting on Sunday, September 27. At the same time, we will be offering the service online for those who remain at home.

Please read carefully through the information below regarding both options:

In-Person Worship:

- there will be one service offered each Sunday at 11 a.m.
- those wishing to attend must make a reservation no later than 11 a.m. on the preceding Friday by calling the office at 836-7660
- masks will be worn during the entire service
- the service will be approximately 1/2 hour and will NOT include singing. Instrumental music will be offered.
- worshippers will be seated a minimum of 6 feet apart in all directions
- adjustments have been made in the service to avoid passing objects
- those attending are asked to take their temperatures that morning at home and then to attest that they have done so before entering the sanctuary. Temperatures should be no higher than 100 degrees Fahrenheit. A temperature check will be conducted at the church should you forget to do one yourself.
- worshippers will enter and exit through either the FRONT DOORS facing Main St. OR through the RAMP ENTRANCE off the parking lot.
- the Lift is available for those unable to use the stairs
- the handicapped bathroom on the lower level near the Fellowship Room is available for worshippers
- please email or call the office with your joys and concerns before each Sunday's service
- there will be no Fellowship Time or Christian Education on Sundays at this time.

We encourage those who are at higher health risks from Covid-19 to remain at home and continue worshipping with us online.

Online Worship:

- We will live-stream the service at 11 a.m. on Sunday through Facebook
- that same service will be recorded and available on UPC's Facebook page later in the day for those who wish to access it at their convenience.
- You DO NOT have to have a Facebook account to access the worship service on Facebook
- If a window pops up asking you to create a Facebook account, you can just click on the words "Not Now" and the window will go away
